

AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS

CAMWS AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN COLLEGE TEACHING

This award recognizes outstanding teaching in Classics at colleges and universities within CAMWS territory. The winner of this award receives \$500. Both full- and part-time teachers (who teach at least half-time with a minimum of five years teaching experience) are eligible for the award. The nominee must be a member in good standing of CAMWS.

The nomination and application process take place in the fall and awards are announced at the annual CAMWS business meeting.

Candidates should submit:

- 1. A current CV, typed, in 12-point font.
- A maximum of three letters of support from administrators and/or peer colleagues. Letters must be typed, in 12-point font, and should not exceed two pages.
- 3. A maximum of three letters of support from students (preferably past students). Letters must be typed, in 12-point font, and should not exceed two pages.
- 4. A statement of teaching philosophy, typed, in 12-point font, not to exceed two pages.
- 5. A high-resolution color photograph (jpeg) for publicity purposes.
