THE JOHN BREUKER JR. AWARD FOR EXCEPTIONAL PROMISE IN LATIN TEACHING

The John Breuker Jr. Award for Exceptional Promise in Latin Teaching is granted to secondary-school educators of demonstrated excellence to support their attendance at a group-study tour of their choice, as well as encouraging their ongoing engagement in the professional societies where the collegial networks launched on that tour can enhance their opportunities for further professional growth.

This annual grant of **\$5,000** is intended to cover expenses (including travel) associated with a foreign group-study program, with a preference for Latin studies and Italian experiences. Applicants should have been members of CAMWS for a minimum of three years.

John Breuker Jr. spent the majority of his teaching career at Western Reserve Academy, and he recognized the considerable value of shared experiences with professional colleagues in multiple societal networks. This award in his honor aspires to build upon teachers' initial successes, opening additional developmental opportunities while retaining those gifted individuals in their Latin classrooms.

Awards are announced prior to the annual meeting. The recipient will be announced at the CAMWS Annual business meeting.

Deadline for receipt of applications is January 30.
