CAMWS TEACHING AWARDS

Kraft Award for Excellence in Secondary School Teaching

Named for CAMWS benefactor Eunice E. Kraft, this award recognizes outstanding teachers of Latin in public or private schools (middle schools included) within CAMWS territory. The honoree receives \$500, airfare to the Annual Meeting, and two nights' accommodation at the convention hotel. Nominees will be eligible for consideration for three consecutive years. The nominee must be a member in good standing of CAMWS. No previous winner of the Kraft Award is eligible to apply for it a second time.

The nominations and applications are reviewed in the fall. Awards are announced at the annual CAMWS business meeting.

Candidates should submit:

- 1. A current CV, typed, in 12-point font.
- 2. A maximum of three letters of support from administrators and/or peer colleagues. Letters must be typed, in 12-point font, and should not exceed two pages.
- 3. A maximum of three letters of support from students (preferably past students). Letters must be typed, in 12-point font, and should not exceed two pages.
- 4. A statement of teaching philosophy, typed, in 12-point font, not to exceed two pages.
- 5. A high-resolution color photograph (jpg) for publicity purposes.
