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| 1986 – 1997 | One poetry and one prose exam offered each year. |
| 1998 – 2014 | One exam offered each year, with an annual poetry / prose alternation. |
| 2015 – | Intermediate and Advanced levels of competition. (Intermediate is always prose – either an easy authentic passage or an adapted passage. Annual poetry / prose alternation continues for Advanced.) College students eligible to participate. |
